The University of New Mexico Board of Regents will hold a Special Meeting on Monday, February 12, 2007, at 4:30 p.m. in the Isleta Board Room of the Albuquerque Hilton Hotel, which is located on University and Menaul Boulevards, Albuquerque, New Mexico.
