UNM Regents Schedule Special Meeting

The Board of Regents of the University of New Mexico will hold a special meeting on Wednesday, May 2, 2007, at 8:30 a. m. in room 101 of Scholes Hall on the UNM main campus.

The agenda for the meeting will be as follows:

1. Adoption of agenda and establishment of quorum.
2. Vote to close the meeting, pursuant to the exclusion for limited personnel matters contained in section 10-15-1 H (2), NMSA 1978.
3. Vote to reopen the meeting.
4. Certification that only those matters described in item 2 above were discussed in executive session and, if necessary, notification of actions, if any, taken in executive session.
5. Adjournment.
