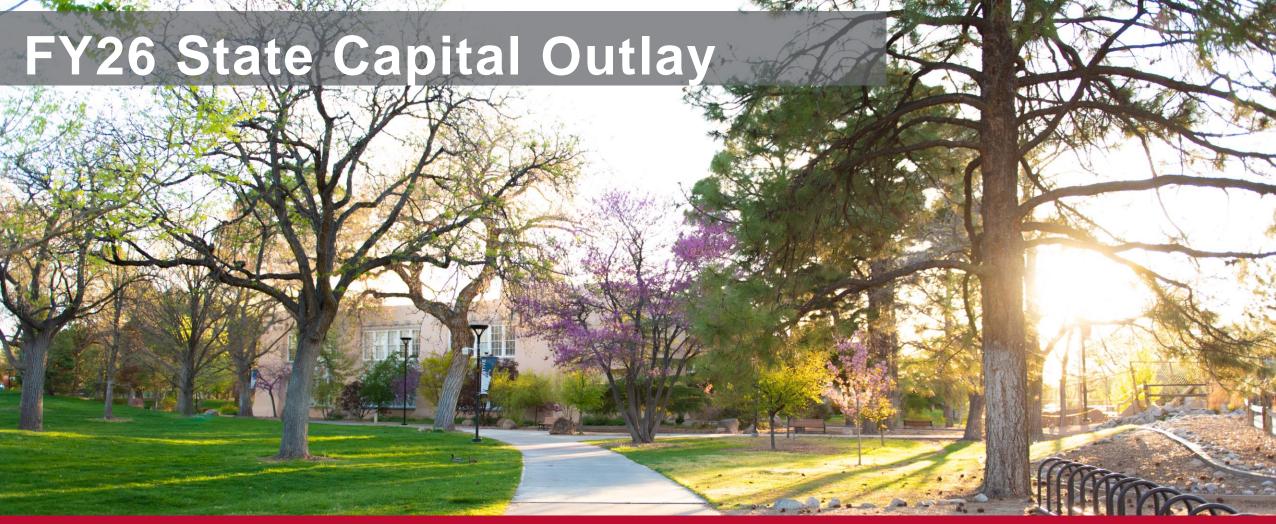














Capital Plan Process

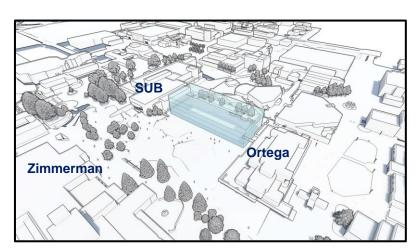

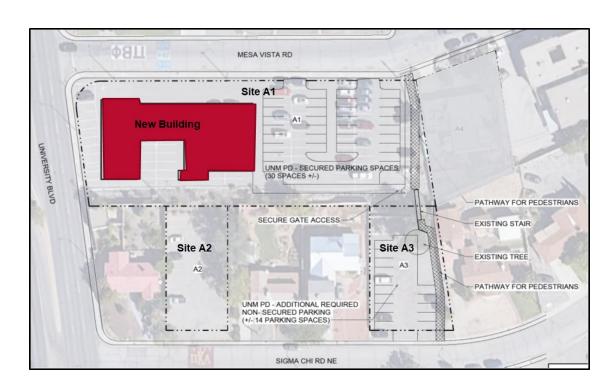

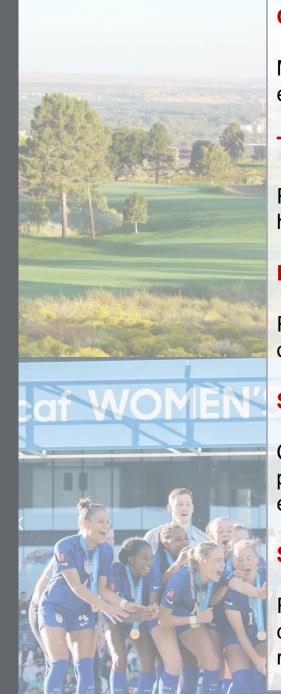


## Athletics: Title IX Improvements

\$18,500,000 Total Request

Build upon past six years of investments in women's athletic facilities

- Respond to Title IX deficiencies
- Elevate women's athletics facilities



**GOLF: \$2.5M** 

Modernization of locker and team rooms, coaches' offices, equipment and updated signage, furniture, and technology.

**TENNIS: \$2M** 

Replace competition courts in McKinnon complex which have become largely unplayable.

**BASKETBALL: \$3.75M** 

Renovate athletic training rooms, team film, coaches' offices, technology, and video boards.

SOCCER: \$6.5M

Construct new team complex for soccer, cross-country programs. Includes locker, team, training, conference & equipment rooms and video board.

SOFTBALL: \$3.75M

Renovate existing softball team facilities and improve concourse and press box. Locker room, team room, meeting space and training.



## NM Law Center Building Renovation

#### **Existing Conditions**

- NM Law Center, Building 230
- Located between Bratton Hall and New Mexico Court of Appeals
- Gave up leasehold in 1974
- Reacquired leasehold in July 2023
- Judicial Education Center moved to Administrative Office of the Courts in October 2023
- Approximately 11,800 Square Feet

#### **Prioritized Project:**

- Repurpose NM Law Center to expand law school and elevate student experience
- New flexible classroom spaces for educational innovation
- Strategically group functions to maximize space usage in both buildings for ease of access for students, faculty, and staff.

#### Future Funding Requests (not Included):

 Establish a connection between NM Law Center and Bratton to strengthen visibility and unify the entry for the School of Law.
